We are the MARCS Babylab, a world-leading infant research facility, and this study is funded by the HEARing Cooperative Research Centre.



What is this project about?

The project– the Seeds of Language Development– is an investigation of language development in infants. To understand the relationship between hearing impairment and language development, two groups of babies, with or without a hearing impairment, will be studied.

Babies first visit the lab at 5 months of age, then every 3 to 6 months over a period until they are 3 years old. Procedures are in the form of games; they are fun and enjoyable.
