We are seeking infants in this age group, both with and without hearing loss, to participate in a research project that aims to improve the early speech perception development in children born with hearing loss.

What's involved?

We are using a new child-friendly optical imaging technique, in combination with a behavioural assessment, to study how children's brains respond to sound, and how the brain develops over time to support language development.

The imaging system (see picture) consists of a cap that has little light sources and detectors, which the child wears while listening to sounds.
